

The Lady Maryland

The Lady Maryland is an 104 ft pungy topsail schooner. Along with being a pungy topsail schooner, she is also gaff-rigged and wood hulled. Lady Maryland was launched in 1986, designed by Thomas C. Gillmer, and built by a team of shipwrights along with some students.

Since she was built, she has been used for educational programs and trips with a group called the Living Classrooms Foundation. With this program they use her to travel to and from different places from Maryland to Massachusetts. This boat has went places such as Salem, New Bedford, and much more.



This boat is the only pungy schooner in existence to this day. Pungy schooners are mainly known for carrying goods through the Chesapeake Bay and from Bermuda to Baltimore.
