### **Skipper Membership: \$800 early bird, \$900 regular season (April-October)**

- May reserve any J22, Sonar, Freedom, or Hansa/Access Dinghy in our fleet
  - Those who check out on the Fevas may use them with supervision

#### J22/Sonar skippers

- Are encouraged to attend three or more work parties during the year
- Are expected to participate in member sails as skippers and engage in the community (racing, cruising, and/or rec sailing) on a consistent basis
- Must attend an annual skipper orientation and pass an on-the-water check-out
- *DSC Skippers must know how to sail. If you want to join but have not sailed in a while, join at the "Crew" level and/or take lessons.*

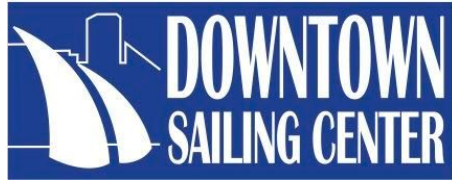
Skipper and Crew additions such as Cruising and Racing can be added on during the sign-up process for an additional fee.

### **Junior Skipper (18-26 yrs old): \$375 early bird, \$425 regular season**

- All the benefits and expectations of the regular skipper membership designed for our next generation of sailors

### **Crew Membership: \$325 early bird, \$400 regular season (April-October)**

- Complementary Taste of Sailing 3 hour introductory lesson for first time members
- Recreational sailing, including Wednesday and Sunday member sails, and member program events



#### Crew members

- Are encouraged to attend two or more work parties during the year and pledge hours for volunteer work.
- No prior experience necessary, though we do encourage lessons

Crew additions such as Cruising and Racing can be added on during the sign up process for an additional fee.

#### **NEW! Youth Membership (U18): Early Bird \$225; Regular Season \$250**

- Weekly youth member sails June-August, using the Hansa/Access Dinghies and RS Fevas
- Youth who pass the skipper checkout may reserve the boats with the same privileges as adults
- Invitation to monthly Friday socials and other DSC events (supervision required)
- Recreational sailing, including Wednesday and Sunday member sails, and member program events

#### **Social Member - \$99.00**

Social membership is designed for people who want to be a part of the membership but have their own boats or no longer live in the area.

- Social Members are not eligible for member sails
- Invitation to monthly Friday socials

#### **Volunteer - FREE!! - Free**

Free to join! ... But expected to *Volunteer*

- Background Check required for volunteers
- Volunteer Opportunities include:
  - Adaptive Sailing - Monday evenings, Saturday mornings
  - Out of School Time Sailing - Monday-Thursday afternoons
  - Sailing Instruction, Race Committee
  - Boat Maintenance
